How to reach NBU

The location of the University of North Bengal is well-placed for easy access to three Railway Stations (including two junction stations) and an Airport. The Campus is centred along NH-31 (Asian Highway-2) at Raja Rammohanpur, about 8 km from Siliguri and 7 km from Bagdogra airport. Siliguri is a major tier-II city in West Bengal. The city spans areas of the Darjeeling and Jalpaiguri districts in the Indian state of West Bengal, known as the "Gateway of Northeast India". It is located on the banks of the Mahananda River and the Teesta River at the foothills of the Himalayas.
