DETAILED INFORMATION FOR UNIVERSITY WEBSITE

Minimum qualifications as per UGC Regulations and State Government Orders:

Assistant Professor (Contractual)

Consolidated Remuneration: Rs. 49100/- (Rupees Forty Nine Thousand One Hundred only)

- i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Masters Degree level in a relevant subject with specialization in Pharmaceutis.
- ii) The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC (CSIR) or similar test accredited by the UGC like NET/SLET/SET, along with exemptions to specified categories, as explained in the Note.

NOTE

1. NET/SLET/SET Exemption for the Post of Assistant Professor:

- i. The candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in the same or in a relevant subject in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 are exempted from qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET).
- ii. Candidates registered for Ph.D. programme prior to 11 July, 2009 shall be exempted from qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET) as described hereinafter :

The award of Degree to candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye laws/ Regulations of the institutions awarding the Degree in the same or relevant subject shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D work.
- f) (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor /Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions).

2. Desirable Qualification

a. (For the post of Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Technology) : Ph.D in Pharmacy / Pharmaceutical Sciences / Pharmaceutical Technology.

b. (For the post of Assistant Professor in Geology): Ph.D in Geology or Applied Geology.
