MCA Admission 2020-2021

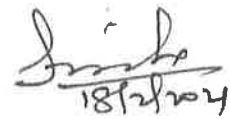
One day spot counseling cum admission process for MCA 1st Semester 2020-2021 for 13 vacant seats [Gen- 08, SC- 04 & ST- 01] will be held on 25.02.2021 at the Department of Computer Science & Application, NBU, between 11 A.M. and 1 P.M.

The criteria for admission to the MCA course through JECA will be as follows: BCA, B.Sc. (CS/IT or its equivalent), B.Tech (CSE/IT or its equivalent) with 60% marks (50% for reserve category) in both 10+2 level and graduation.

OR

B.Tech (Non-computing), B.Sc., B.Com, B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 level with 60% marks (50% for reserve category) in both 10+2 level and graduation. In addition to this, these candidates will have to undergo a bridge course of two semesters after enrolling to the MCA course along with MCA first and second semesters, respectively.

Candidate must have WBJEEB (JECA) General Merit rank of 2020. The list of the selected candidates will be notified on 25.02.2021 at 2.00 p.m. and the selected candidates have to take admission on 25.02.2021 by 3.00 p.m. [Fees Rs. 5903/- + two Anti ragging undertakings].
