Resolution as per Review Meeting held on 20.10.2023 Regarding District Study Centres, SNTCSSC and associated matters.

The following decisions were taken: -

1

- a. Talent Hunt A talent aptitude exam across the district should be conducted to find bloomers i.e. smart students who could be groomed for UPSC Exam. Essay and Debate competitions at school level, should also be part of it.
- (6) Govt. of India Scholarship MAME Department will explore the scope of scholarship of Govt. of India that can be availed by Minority students.
- Alignment of PG level course The Higher Education Department will explore the possibility of aligning Post Graduation course with syllabus of optional subjects of UPSC Exam.
- d Resource Pool District Task Force will take initiatives to form a resource pool of expert faculties from Higher Education Institutions, who may guide aspirants of district study centres for optional subjects. All major optional subjects shall have good resource persons. Such off-line sessions should be planned on weekends. SNTCSSC will explore possibilities for providing remuneration to the resource pool of expert faculties.
- e. Translation The Higher Education Department will take initiatives to translate important books and magazines of UPSC exam. Translated material will be beneficial for the aspirants preparing in Bengali medium
- f. Availability of Newspapers SNTCSSC will explore the possibility of bulk subscription of newspapers such as The Hindu and Indian Express. This subscription will be helpful to aspirants of district study centres
- g. Important articles SNTCSSC Kolkata will upload important articles on its website. Such articles may also be translated in Bengali.

#### 2. IEC ACTIVITIES

- Extensive awareness The District Task Force will conduct awareness activities across the district to reach out to all potential aspirants.
- Sensitization of Faculties Special awareness sessions will be planned to sensitize college faculty members and the school teachers.
- c. Hubs of Learning It is a recent initiative of HED. Integrated clusters formed in the districts should be utilized for awareness activities for UPSC Exam.
- d. Target Colleges and Alumni undergraduate students and alumni of colleges should be targeted for awareness by the District Task Force.
- e IEC material SNTCSSC Kolkata shall provide SOP and video for utilization as materials for spreading awareness.

#### 3. CONSOLIDATED EFFORT

- Monthly Review District Level Task Force chaired by respective District Magistrates, shall review the performance of study centres, once every month
- b. Reprography Unit The Higher Education Department will set up a reprography unit, with the help of District Task Force, to help aspirants in accessing basic materials of preparation.
- c. Book Materials The Higher Education Department will take suitable steps to provide 10 sets of important books related to Civil Service Examinations, at each centre. SNTCSSC Kolkata will provide the list of books to HED.
- d Mentor Session Direct IAS, IPS and IFoS officers will take mentoring sessions every week in an off-line mode at district study centres. District Task Force will ensure that it is done regularly.
- e. Visit of Institute KSG institute conducting the course, shall visit each district study centre at least once in three months
- f. Regular Mock Tests Every week one offline mock test will be conducted at each district study centre. Question paper will be provided by the KSG institute and district task force will conduct the test.
- g. Wild Card entry Aspirants not giving tests regularly may be replaced with other eligible & deserving aspirants. The decision of District Task Force will be final and a copy will be sent to SNTCSSC Kolkata for intimation.
- h. Counselling Centres The District Task Force will take initiatives to form counselling centres at district and sub-division levels to counsel students for making better career choices. Integrated clusters may be utilized for the purpose.
- Test Subscription SNTCSSC Kolkata shall arrange test subscription of institutes that conduct national level tests such as Vision IAS, Forum IAS etc.
- j. English and Mathematics Sessions District Task Force shall conduct special sessions on English and Mathematics that will improve aptitude level.

- Students outside the study centre may also be allowed to attend such sessions.
- k. IAS IPS IFoS tagging Each district study centre shall have one IAS, one IPS and one IFoS tagged to the centre. These officers will visit the study centre on a weekly basis.
