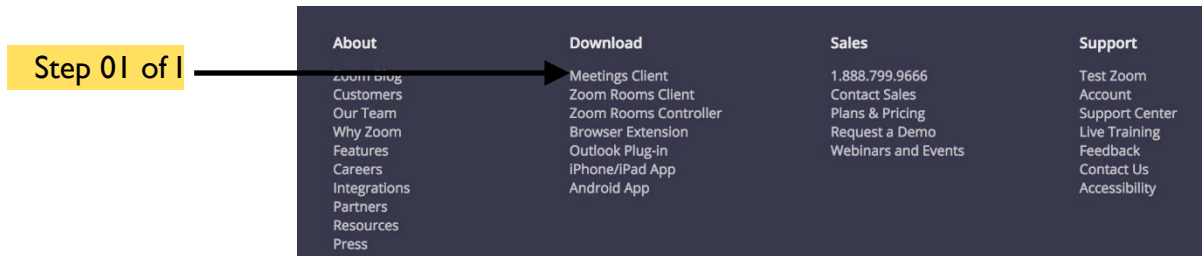
## I. For Windows

### Downloading the Meetings Client:

#### Step 01

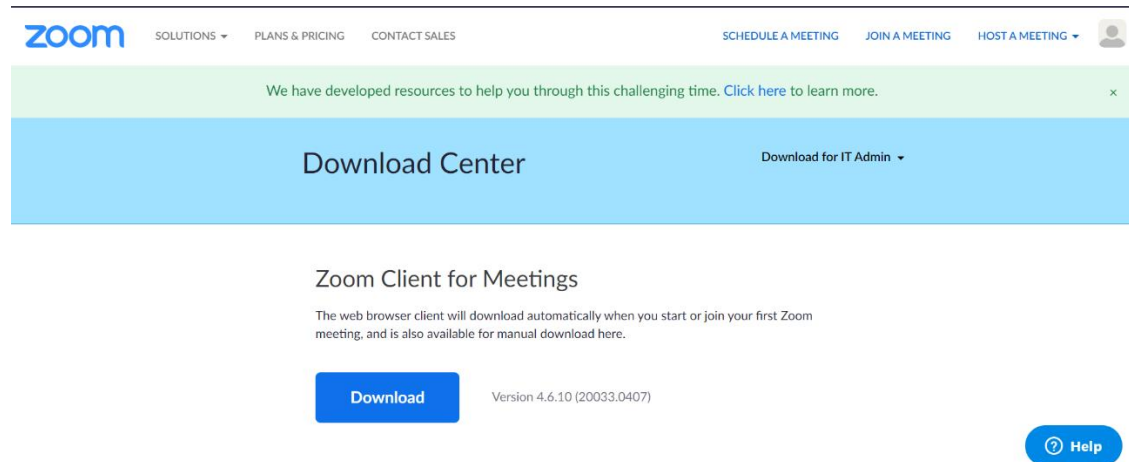
You will need to download the Zoom Meetings Client from <https://zoom.us>.

Scroll to the bottom of the page. Click on the **Meetings Client** link under the Downloads section of the menu.



#### Step 02

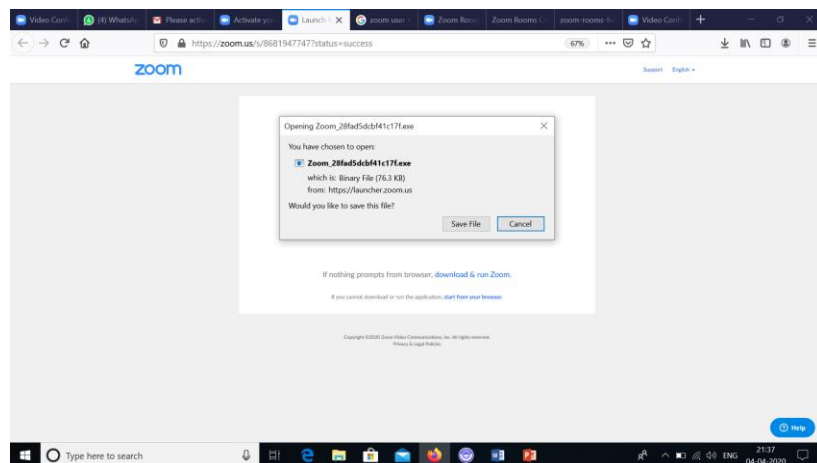
This will take you to the ZOOM Download Center and click the Download button for Zoom Client for Meetings.



#### Step 03

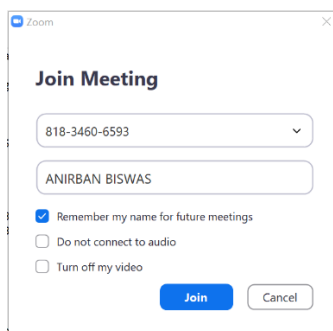
This will take you to the ZOOM Download Center and click the Download button for **Zoom Client for Meetings**. A launcher application will be available to download and **install the application into your system**.



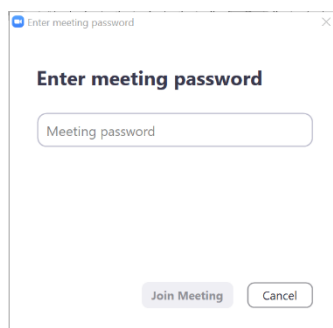


## Step 04

- A. Open the Zoom Meeting Client (From Computer Program/Menu).
- B. Click **Join a Meeting**, enter the meeting id provided by your teacher (818 3460 \*\*\*\*) and click the join button.



- C. Enter the password provided by your teacher.



- D. Join the meeting.
